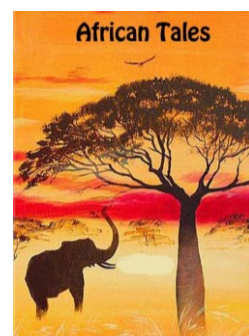
REPORTS:

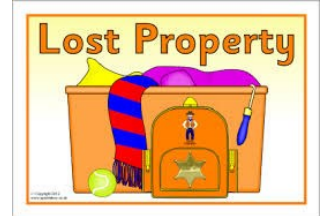
