PoPI COMPLIANT COMMUNICATION AT CAMPS BAY PRIMARY SCHOOL:

As a Western Cape Education Department School, we must aim to be PoPI (Protection of Personal Information) Act compliant which affects how we communicate as a school community. For those who don't know, the PoPI Act is there to ensure that all South African institutions conduct themselves in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing another entity's personal information by holding them accountable should they abuse or compromise your personal information in any way.

What this means for us as a school is that we need to ensure that all our pupils, parents and teachers personal information is protected. This means that any communication, on behalf of the school, **must not share any personal contact information** - i.e. email addresses or cell phone numbers.

Therefore, the school will not share class lists with contact details to all parents as previously done. All communication will either be sent out directly from the school via Rene at the Primary Campus or Caron at the Prep Campus or by a teacher using Staffroom's In Touch Portal or via bcc'd (blind copied) emails or via WhatsApp broadcast messages. All these communication methods hide private contact details and information, and do not allow for public conversations. The school is in the process of drawing up a more detailed communications policy but in the meantime, we will strive to be PoPI compliant.

ABSENTEEISM FOR ASSESSMENTS:

There have been a number of children affected by a tummy virus and nausea attacks in the last week which has increased the rate of absenteeism. A number of assessments are scheduled to take place in the next fortnight in various grades so hopefully children are well enough to be present at school for these assessments. The CAPS curriculum involves continuous assessments during the course of the term in Term 1 so it is imperative for children to be present and only absent for medical reasons, as it is very difficult for the teacher to arrange for the child(ren) to rewrite/redesign the assessment(s). *The policy is that a learner who is absent for an assessment must write the assessment on his/her day of return to school to prevent any further compromise of the assessment/test.* Thanking you for your understanding and support and hopefully the dreaded tummy bug disappears soon!
