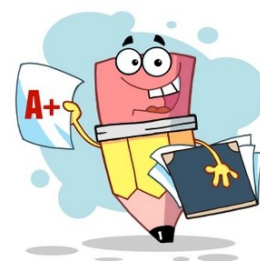


They received a wonderful floating trophy and their gold medals, and are now the South African National Champions for Hobie 16 Sailing.
