Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

Welcome back to all our families. I trust you all enjoyed a rather short holiday and you are ready to become involved in what promises to be a good year! I have no doubt 2019 is going to be another exciting year at Camps Bay Primary School!



I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all our new children and parents to the Camps Bay Primary School 'family'. We have many new pupils at Camps Bay Primary this year and have three classes per grade from grades R to 7. The total number of children enrolled at the school is 239 on the prep campus and 385 learners on the primary campus which is a total of 624 children at present!

Welcome back to the teaching, administration and support staff. A special welcome to the new staff members, namely, Mr Stefan Filter (grade 5SF), Ms Anita Potgieter (Learning Support), Mr Matthew Schenck (Sports Co-ordinator/PE) and Mr Hlumelo Notoko (Prep Sports Co-ordinator & Grade 3 PE).

WEEK 2 AND ONWARDS: School will close at normal times:

Monday to Thursday 14:30

Friday 13:00 for Grade 3 and 13:30 for the rest of the school.

ASSESSMENT TIMETABLES: Grades 4 to 7

Assessment timetables for Grades 4 to 7 for Term 1 were sent out on Tuesday.

Please ask your child for the assessment timetable to help support your child in preparation for assessments, tests and ensuring that tasks are completed timeously!

SCHOOL UNIFORM:

All learners must arrive at school in their full school uniform and bring their PE clothes / sports clothes with them and change at school for PE or sport. Children are no longer permitted to wear PE/sports clothes to school as the stage 5 water restrictions have been lifted. Please encourage children to take pride in the way he/she wears his/her school uniform as well as to continue saving water!

CELLPHONES:

Children are discouraged from bringing cellphones to school unless they are really needed.

Grades 3 to 6: cellphones must be switched off on school premises and handed in at the office for safe-keeping on arrival at school in the mornings. Cellphones must then be collected from the office at the end of the school day.

Grade 7: Cellphones must be switched off on arrival at school and handed into class teacher at start of the day. Grade 7s may use cellphones for educational purposes in the classroom under supervision of teacher. No smartphones/watch phone devices in the classroom!

We need to control the use of cellphones by children at school and cannot be responsible for lost/stolen cellphones if not handed in at the office on arrival at school. Thank you for your understanding.

USE OF OFFICE PHONE:

The office phone will only be allowed to be used by a learner in an emergency. Children will not be permitted to phone home for trivial matters such as left PE clothes/book/project/lunch at home.

CBHS MATRIC RESULTS 2018:

Congratulations to Camps Bay High School, Mr De Korte and the high school teachers on the excellent matric results in 2018. The CBHS matric class of 2018 achieved a 99.2% pass rate.

The school also achieved a Bachelor's pass rate of 84.6%, granting matriculants access to university. 13 matric students achieved an 80% and above aggregate! SYMMONDS FIELD AFTER SPORT:

The standard procedure is for ALL children to return to the school under the guidance of a teacher/coach to be collected safely from the school. We cannot have children collected or waiting at the Symmonds Field as this is not safe. Camps Bay Drive is also an extremely busy road and very dangerous for children to be crossing. In the interests of safety and security all children are to be accounted for and collected from the school premises. Thank you for your support.

All pupils must be on campus each morning by 07:50.

Pupils report to the following venues: Grades 3: Chessboard area, Grades 4 & 5: 5-a-side
Grades 6 & 7: Netball court

In the event of rain, children report to the Hall. When the bell rings at 07:50 pupils line-up, from which classes will be directed to the various class venues. Any pupil reporting after 08:00 must report to the office – pupils will then receive a 'Late Slip'.

I am pleased to inform you that Ms Michelle Fernandes has again volunteered to be the convenor of the tuckshop this year. 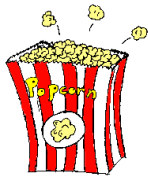
