MATRIC RESULTS 2011:



Congratulations to the Camps Bay High matric class of 2011 on the excellent final matric results. Twelve (11,7%) of the 102 matriculants achieved A-aggregates (over 80%) and 29 learners achieved aggregates of over 70%. In addition, 77% of the class achieved university endorsements to attend university and the pass rate was 98%. A number of former Camps Bay Primary learners achieved A-aggregates. We are very proud of them and the CBHS matric class of 2011. Well done! We wish them well as many of the matriculants will be studying at tertiary institutions and universities this year.
