REPORTS:

PARENT PORTAL:

You need to use your email address that you provided to the school as your username and create a password of your choice. Once this has been done an email link will be sent to your email to enable you to validate the account – you simply need to click on the link to gain access. This will enable you to access your child's report.

How do I register on the Staffroom parent portal?

Step 1: Open the web browser (Safari, Chrome, FireFox) on either of your mobile devices, tablet or your PC and click the register link. <https://cbps.intouch.zone/public/login/parent>

Step 2: You will then create an account and password for the portal using your email address provided to the school.

Step 3: Once this has been done an email link is sent to your email to enable you to validate the account - you simply need to click on the link.

Step 4: Once this has been done you can log onto the parental portal at anytime using this username and password. Thanking you for your support and please complete this process asap to avoid any problems accessing your child's report next week.

SPORT REGISTRATION: Term 2 & 3, 2020:

Next week the winter sport sign-up for Terms 2 and 3 will take place to facilitate an earlier start to sport at the start of next term. We request that you carefully discuss with your child the choice(s) of the sport in which your child would like to participate. When children sign up for a code, they also agree to partake in all practices and fixtures until the end of each season for both terms 2 and 3. The winter sports extra-mural programme will be sent home by the end of the week. The sports registration is an important process as based on the registration a commitment is made to play the sport for the full duration of the season (terms 2 & 3) and teams entered into respective leagues. This assists with their load as well as alleviates sports codes becoming over-subscribed in certain codes while other codes have very few children.
