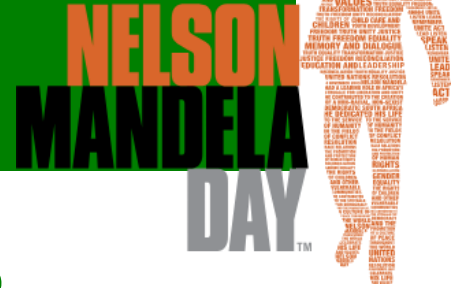




WELCOME BACK FOR TERM 3
