PAST PUPIL SURVEY FOR GRADE 7 CLASS OF 2022



One of the most accurate ways to measure the quality of our school is to ask our past learners about how well they were prepared for high school. We started this process last year for the first time and this week launched our survey again. Historically, our learners have moved from this school to high quality high schools. This is important because if we are not preparing our children to be able to succeed in institutions of high standard, we would be failing our children.

The results will be shared with the staff and our families once they have been collated. The survey questions are as follows:

1. I think that Camps Bay Primary has given my child a good academic foundation for further progress at High School.
2. I feel that my child is able to cope well with the workload and organisational expectations of High School.
3. I think that my child has the necessary ICT (computer) skills to cope at the school he/she is attending.
4. I think my child has the necessary grounding in sport to cope well and participate meaningfully in High School offerings.
5. I think my child was given a good grounding in the cultural subjects of Music, Art and Drama.
6. I think that Camps Bay Primary communicates well with parents.
7. I think that opportunities are given for parents to engage according to their preference at Camps Bay Primary.
8. My Child was accepted into their High School of Choice?
9. Which High School does your child now attend?
10. How would you rate the overall standard of education at Camps Bay Primary?
11. I feel that my child had a positive primary experience at Camps Bay Primary and I am confident about recommending the school to others.

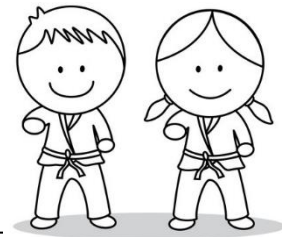

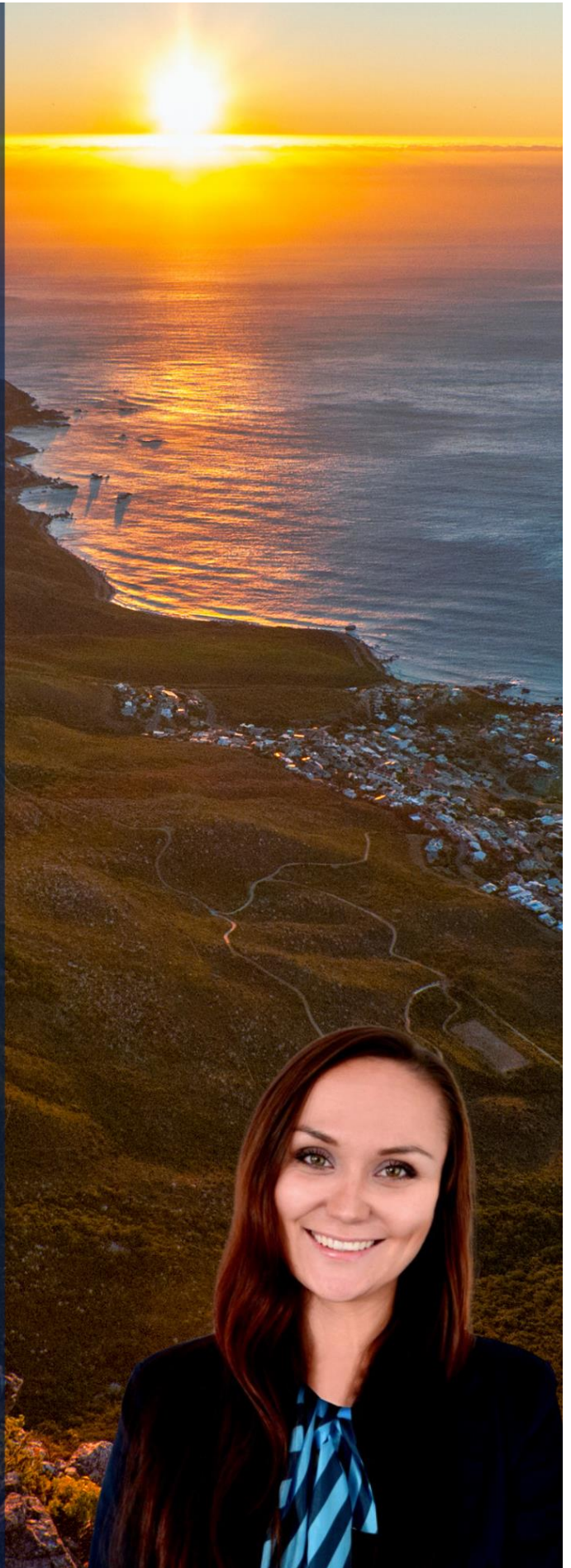
