TOWN PLANNING APPLICATION AT THE PRE-PREP CAMPUS - 18 THE DRIVE

Some parents have noted the signs indicating an application for consolidation of Erven at the Prep School Grade R Campus and there are questions about what is happening and who is driving the process. We apologise for any confusion created, as this was an innocuous process that we didn't feel the need to communicate since it was an SGB decision taken last year to regularise the work already done but given local sensitivities, we do appreciate the potential for consternation in retrospect. Hopefully this communication rights that misstep.

The land is owned by the City of Cape Town, leased to the Western Cape Education Department who in turn, have since 2020 leased it to CBPS. The land occupied by the Prep campus is a collection of a number of Erven, even including a road reserve on part of the new parking lot, which is zoned as such. We felt it important to neaten (from a management and utilities perspective) and protect the existing school buildings on one property, which corresponds to the area leased. The process was thus initiated by the SGB - the departures and restrictions removal are in respect of existing (long standing) buildings and whilst the original (Stage 2) plans anticipated the addition of more classrooms (new development), this is not anticipated in the foreseeable future as the plans were parked during the Covid lockdown period. We have allowed for that possibility in the future. The zoning remains as it is - Community Use for Educational purposes.


In terms of what learners wear for matches or sporting events, please may I bring your attention to the following:


