SPORT IN THE SPOTLIGHT

We have reached the end of the term as far as sport is concerned and on reflection, progress has been made. The growth and development that happens I sport is gradual as our children develop their coordination, strength, fitness and skill. There is a vast difference between what happens at age 8 and at age 12. This is especially evident in skill levels and the understanding the importance of positional play rather than all just running after a ball. The "product" is seen at senior level where we can measure the success of our programme by how well we compete with other similar schools. Last weekend our rugby players did



extremely well in the 7s Tournament held at Van Ribeeck Primary School. The benefit of our relationship with Hamilton's Rugby Club showed, especially with our unbeaten U11 team.



Our Netball girls also participated in a tournament in Kuils Rivier last weekend which involved a large number of the strongest Netball Schools. It was tough to be thrust into this level of competition, however, their spirit and determination showed, and they can feel proud of what they achieved. NAPTOSA CONFERENCE



tuck shop providers.


FILMING CONTINUES




