This year, we launched a new extension programme for young mathematicians called Flex Club. During the Flex lessons, learners 'do problem solving' - they practise the ability to puzzle it out without reverting to learnt procedural knowledge. The aim is to equip them with knowledge and skills to think flexibly, creatively and logically 'out of the box.' Problem solving, in a nutshell, is knowing what to do when you don't know what to do. It promotes deep understanding, fosters an appreciation for the beauty of mathematics and endeavours to encourage a fearless attitude towards challenges.

It was great to recognise the achievements of our 'Flexers' who participated in the annual South African Mathematics Challenge this year during our Friday assembly. Across the country, almost 85000 learners participated, of which approximately $20 \%$ qualified to write the second round.
