PARENT PORTAL REMINDER:

With reports being released next week here is a reminder of how to access the parent portal. To activate or access the parent portal you need to use your email address that you provided to the school as your username and create a password of your choice. Once this has been done an email link will be sent to your email to enable you to validate the account –



you simply need to click on the link to gain access. This will enable you to access your child's report and teacher-parent communication such as homework, assessment timetables and other announcements, including information relevant to a specific grade.

How do I register on the Staffroom parent portal?

- Step 1: Open the web browser (Safari, Chrome, FireFox) on either of your mobile devices, tablet or your PC and click the register link. https://cbps.intouch.zone/public/login/parent
- Step 2: You will then create an account and password for the portal using your email address provided to the school.
- Step 3: Once this has been done an email link is sent to your email to enable you to validate the account you simply need to click on the link.
- Step 4: Once this has been done you can log onto the parental portal at anytime using this username and password




