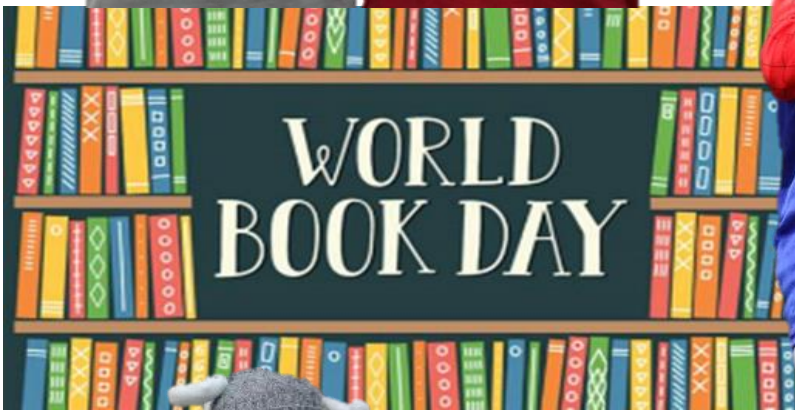

An historic event occurred this week when Camps Bay Primary hosted its first-ever group of exchange students from Mauritius. Eight pupils and their teachers from Ecole du Nord, Mauritius, arrived late on Sunday evening to spend the week with our Grade 7 Pupils as part of a Cultural Exchange Programme.



The project was birthed between our two schools in October last year when Mrs Hamber connected with a school in Mauritius wanting to visit a South African school. They loved our location and website which prompted them to contact us.

The pupils attended two full school days and joined the Gr 7s for part of their camp at Rocklands. After that, they toured a number of destinations around our beautiful Cape. 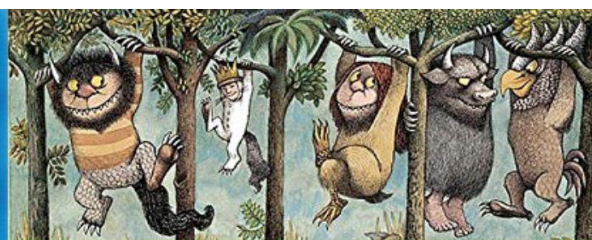
