Nic Spaull's talk will be followed by the presentation of the 2023 school budget
















This year the PTA will be repeating **the successful second hand text book sale** at the primary campus. Do it for the planet and your pocket! Support this school initiative.

### Creating complex 2D shapes using Number Sense attribute blocks.



Attribute blocks support the development of reasoning; the understanding of shape and the properties of shapes; and are used in activities that involve sorting, pattern completion and extension.

We have adopted Number Sense as our programme of choice in our school because it supports the development of a solid sense of number and a deeper understanding of mathematics. The programme is responsive to the developmental needs of children and how children learn mathematics.
