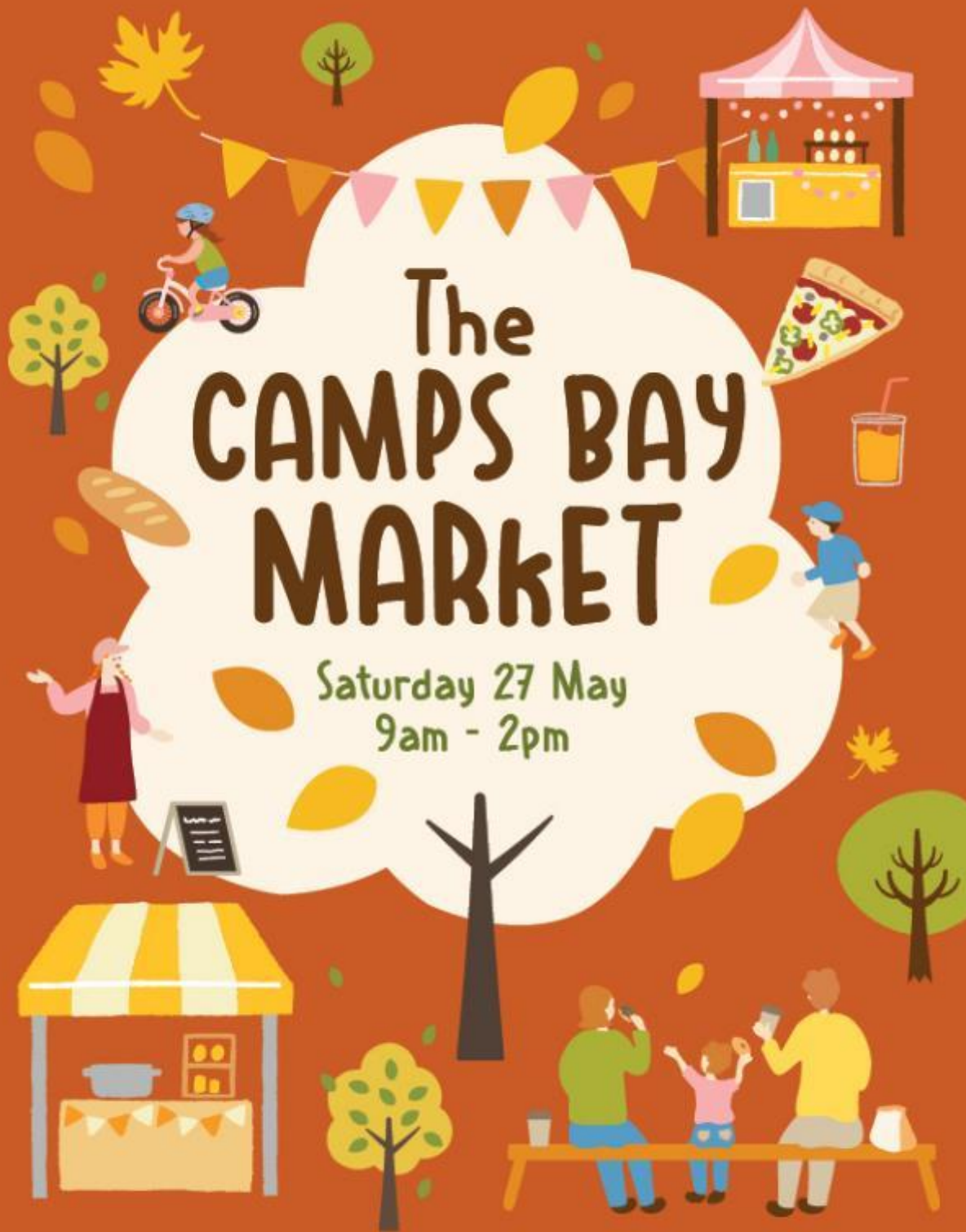
Thank you to all our seniors who have offered their time and skill to assist younger learners with reading at break on Tuesday and Wednesday. This makes a huge difference for those

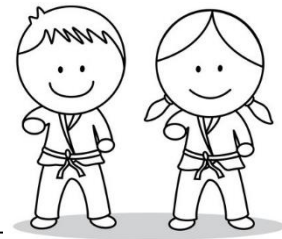

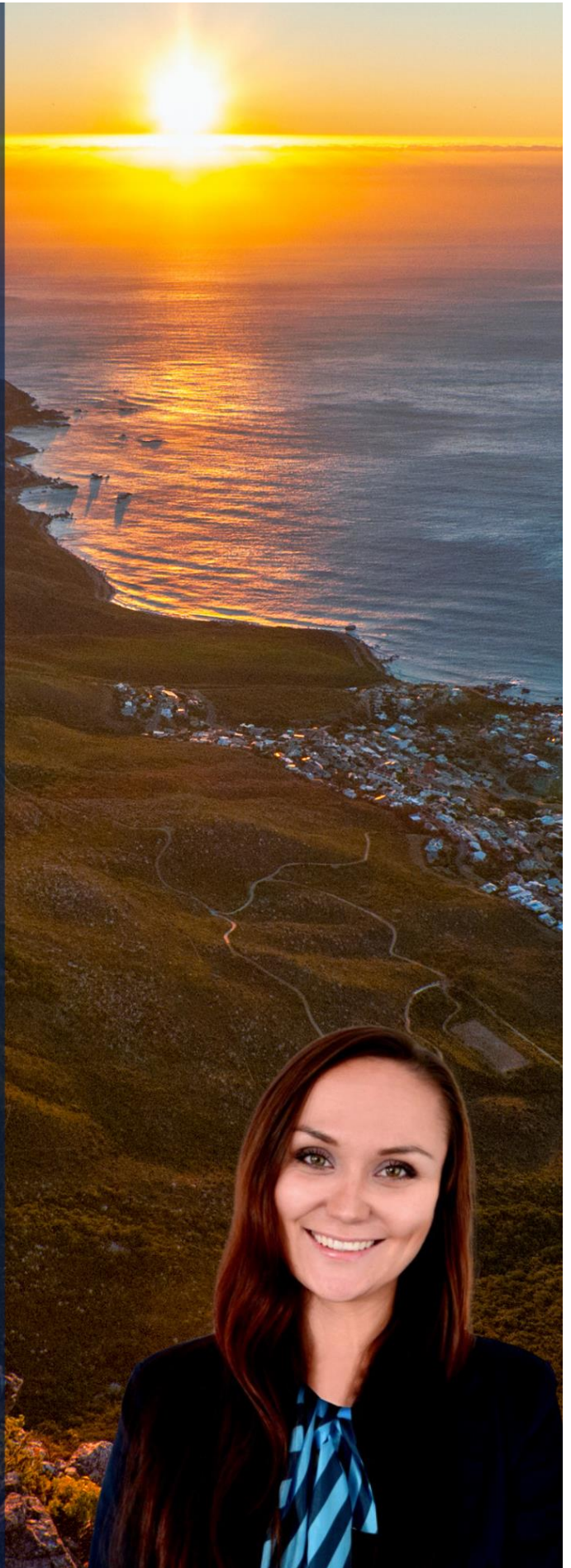
